# ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION SUNDAY 19 MAY 2024

There will be a rolling programme of road closures starting from Anchor Road at 04:00 on Sunday 19 May 2024 in order to ensure a safe running route for the 15,000 runners taking part. Please see the map overleaf for details of the route, road closures and diversions. All roads should be reopened by 17:00.

Roads will be reopened in phases once each section is clear of runners, litter and event infrastructure.

During the road closure, vehicular access will not be possible. Unless otherwise stated or pre-agreed. We appreciate that road closures can cause some inconvenience but your cooperation would be appreciated in assisting the City of Bristol to host this prestigious sporting event.

Pedestrian and emergency service access will be maintained to all properties throughout the event.

Please make us aware of any concerns regarding the proposed road closures no later than the 15 May 2024.

#### **INFORMATION FOR ALL ZONES**

- Clifton Suspension Bridge will remain open AT ALL TIMES.
- Rolling road closures will be in place for the event as per the colour coded map and zones overleaf.
- The AJ Bell Great Bristol Run will start from 0900 and be followed by multiple wave starts.
- All roads will be reopened by 1700 if not before. The re-opening times listed are a guide and are subject to change due to operational requirements.
- If you require your vehicle during closure times, we recommend you park outside of the road closure area.
- Cars parked on closed roads may be uplifted if parked in suspended spaces and no movement of cars is permitted during road closures. Warning signage and No Parking cones will identify these areas.
- If your vehicle is uplifted, it will be moved to Portwall Lane Car Park or the SS GB car park depending on which is nearest. Any queries on the day please contact parking services on 0117 903 8070.

#### Zone 1

- Anchor Road will be closed between 0400 and 1700.
- Lime Kiln Rd/ Cannons Way residents will be able to enter and/or exit via Partition St/ Lower College St and across Anchor Road until 0830 and after 1230, once it is safe to move vehicles.

#### Zone 2

- Hotwell Road outbound of city to Humphry Davy Way will be closed between 0630 and 1315.
- Access to Dock Gate Lane, Pembroke Place, Rownham Mead, Charles Place, Oakfield Rd, Merchants Road will be restricted between closure times.
- Vehicles will be permitted to exit streets and drive towards Jacobs Wells Roundabout on Hotwell Road until 0830.
- Hotwell Rd will remain open to traffic at all times on the inbound to city side of road, towards Jacobs Wells Roundabout.

#### Zone 3

- Hotwell Road at Bennett Way to A4162 Sylvan Way incl A4
  Portway and Bridge Valley Road will be closed between 0600 and 1445.
- Residents with property's located on The Portway between Sylvan Way and Riverleaze are able to use a vehicle lane installed for the event. Residents are permitted to enter at the Sylvan Way junction on to The Portway and exit on to Riverleaze. Residents are asked not to park cars on the road to ensure access can be maintained.

#### Zone 4

- Avon Crescent, McAdam Way, Brunel Lock Road, Brunswick Place, Cumberland Rd, Wapping Rd, Gas Ferry Rd, Hanover Place, Mardyke Ferry Rd, Smeaton Rd, Ashton Ave, Commercial Road will be closed between 0530 and 1445.
- Residents will be able to exit until 0830, after this time vehicle movement is prohibited, unless prior arrangements have been made with the event organisers.
- If you require your car between 0830 and 1445 we recommend you park outside of the road closure area.
- Avon Crescent can exit onto Brunel Way Southbound at all times.

#### Zone 5

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- Wapping Road, The Grove, Prince Street, Queen Square will be closed between 0600 and 1515.
- The internal pathway in Queen Square will be part of the course. Pedestrian access around the square will be maintained throughout.
- The Grove, Prince Street, Wapping Road, Queen Square, residents will be able to exit until 0845, after this time vehicle movement is prohibited, unless prior arrangements have been made with the event organisers.


#### Zone 6

- Redcliffe Hill (inbound traffic), Redcliffe Way from Redcliffe Bascule Bridge towards Temple Circus, Redcliffe St, Three Queens' Lane, St Thomas St from Phippen St to Three Queens' Lane, Victoria Street, Mitchell Lane, Counterslip, Queen Street, Castle Street, Lower Castle Street, Broad Weir, Newgate, Wine Street, High Street will be closed between 05:30 and 1545.
- Residents will be able to exit until 0845, after this time vehicle movement is prohibited, unless prior arrangements have been made with the event organisers.
- If you require your car between 0845 and 1545 we recommend you park outside of the road closure area.

#### Zone 7

- Baldwin St, Marsh St, Broad Quay, Colston Ave, St Augustine's Parade, Park Street/College Green (access only as far as Anchor Rd and the Marriott Hotel), Lewin's Mead, Christmas Street and Quay Street will be closed between 0700 and 1630.
- Vehicle access into The Centre is restricted during closure time.
- Residents will be able to exit until 0830, after this time vehicle movement is prohibited, unless prior arrangements have been made with the event organisers.
- If you require your car between 0830 and 1630 we recommend you park outside of the road closure.
