## **SUNDAY 26 MAY 2024**

#### Dear Resident/Business Owner,

This year's AJ Bell Great Manchester Run will take place on **Sunday 26th May 2024** and includes both 10k and Half Marathon events. If you're not taking part or can't get out to see the action live, the event will be broadcast **live on BBC One from 11:00 – 13:00** (please check TV listings for up to date timings).

The action kicks off on Portland Street with the Elite Wheelchair Race at 08:15 followed by the AJ Bell Great Manchester Half Marathon at 08:20.

A stellar elite line featuring some of the world's best athletes, who will head out a field of 25000+ competitors in the AJ Bell Great Manchester 10K, starts with the Elite Women's race at 11:25 followed by Elite Men and masses from 11:40.

Several roads within the city will be affected by the events and road closures and traffic diversion plans will be in operation on the day. We'll be installing warning notices before the event. Event stewards will assist traffic and residents wherever possible on the day of the race, allowing access to and from properties within the road closures whenever it is safe to do so up until 08:15. Please note that for safety reasons there can be no access onto the course after this time. We will endeavour to open roads as soon as possible.
